VIRTUAL SCHOOL (2020 - 2022)

- In the wake of the COVID-19 pandemic, G.H.S transitioned to virtual School in March 2020, to continue to provide our students with a learning experience that is aligned with our educational philosophy using the power of digital technologies.
- In the beginning of the session, the worksheets and the videos were sent to the children through E- learn Portal.
- We opted for Microsoft Teams which was not only safe and secure, but also had many robust features and applications to make learning more interactive.
- The Virtual School incorporated subjective and graded subjects for the benefit of the children.
- Our teachers designed and used a wide variety of creative and interactive teaching techniques and activities to enhance the level of understanding of the students.
- Teachers uploaded assignments and students duly submitted it to be evaluated.
- The holistic development of students was achieved through the sessions of Yoga, Music, Art, Quiz Competitions, Elocution which had a positive impact on both their physical health and mental well being. Assemblies, Inter House activities, events and competitions were conducted regularly.
