ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROJECT

INSTRUCTIONS:

- The notebook should be covered properly with coloured paper and name slip should be pasted on it.
- Details such as – Name; Class; Roll No.; Adm. No.; Subject and Subject Teacher's Name to be written on the 1st lined page of the project assignment notebook.

- Each plain side should have the pictures or drawings of the given Naming Words (two pictures or drawings on each page).
- The pictures drawn or pasted should be outlined with black pen and labelled neatly.
