ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROJECT

- Details such as – Name; Class; Roll No.; Adm. No.; Subject and Subject Teacher's Name to be written on the 1st lined page of the project assignment notebook.
- The students should begin writing the project from the ruled side of the next page and the pictures should be pasted on the plain side. All the pictures should be labelled neatly.

TOPIC: OPPOSITES

- Underline the Opposite Words in each of the following sentences -
 1. My books are new but my bag is old.
 2. The rock is hard but the cotton is soft.
 3. Her brother is fat but her sister is thin.
 4. The feather is light but the trunk is heavy.
 5. She is rich but he is poor.
- On the ruled side – Write one sentence on each page and underline the Opposite Words.
- On the plain side – Paste the pictures of the Opposite Words and label each picture. Paste two pictures on one page.
- Total 5 lined pages and 5 plain pages are to be used.

TOPIC: GREATEST AND SMALLEST NUMBER

1. Draw and colour a bunch of balloons. On the balloons write the following numbers and then colour the balloon with the smallest number blue.
 - a. 321, 345, 359, 312
 - b. 452, 419, 478, 460
 - c. 301, 405, 346, 385
2. Draw and colour an aquarium with some fish, plants, sand, stones, etc. Write the following numbers on the fish and then colour the fish with the greatest number yellow.
 - a. 357, 497, 369, 462
 - b. 326, 394, 325, 399
 - c. 452, 434, 489, 420

ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION PROJECT
